**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 038**  
Series of 2021

**AN ORDER IMPLEMENTING THE GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (GCQ) WITH RESTRICTIONS FROM 16 JUNE 2021 UNTIL 30 JUNE 2021 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LOS BAÑOS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 15 Article II of the 1987 Constitution states that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 11469 (RA 11469) declared the state of national emergency over the entire the country and ensure that all Local Government Units (LGUs) are acting within the letter and spirit of all the rules, regulations, and directives issued by the National Government;

**WHEREAS**, the continued implementation of proactive measures and restrictions must be put in place to slow down the surge in COVID-19 cases, stop further spread of variants, buy time for the health system to cope, and to protect more lives;

**WHEREAS**, on 14 June 2021, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF-MEID) issued Resolution No. 121 series of 2021 under Paragraph A (iv) stated that Laguna, Cavite, and Rizal shall remain under General Community Quarantine with heightened restrictions until 30 June 2021;

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2020-0062 in compliance with the Memorandum from the Executive Secretary of the office of the President signed on March 16, 2020, the Local Government Unit of Los Baños protects the health and safety of the community of the Municipality of Los Baños in providing guidelines for COVID-19;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTONIO L. KALAW**, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Los Baños, Province of Laguna, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**SECTION 1. Coverage.** All residents and non-residents of the Municipality of Los Baños as well as all establishments located within the Municipality are covered by this order.

**SECTION 2. Implementing the IATF Resolution No. 121 series of 2021.** The applicable provisions of IATF Resolution No. 121 series of 2021, dated 14 June 2021, for the observance and implementation of a General Community Quarantine (GCQ) with Restrictions, are hereby adopted;

- (a) Food preparation establishments such as commissaries, restaurants, and eateries may operate with their indoor dine-in services at the venue or seating capacity of twenty percent (20%), and with their al fresco or outdoor dine-in services at the venue or seating capacity of fifty percent (50%).
- (b) Personal care services, such as beauty salons, beauty parlors, barbershops, and nail spas, may operate up to thirty percent (30%) venue or seating capacity. For this purpose, these establishments shall only provide services that can accommodate the wearing of face masks at all times by patrons/clients and service providers.
- (c) Meetings, Incentives, Conventions, and Exhibitions (MICE) events in eligible venue establishments shall not be allowed to operate.
- (d) Outdoor tourist attractions shall remain to be allowed at thirty percent (30%) venue capacity with strict adherence to minimum public health standards.
- (e) Under the Safety Seal Certification Program, business establishments awarded Safety Seal Certifications shall be allowed to operate at an additional 10 percentage points beyond the prescribed on-site capacity or venue/seating capacity, whichever is applicable.
- (f) Indoor sports courts and venues and indoor tourist attractions shall not be allowed to operate.
- (g) Specialized markets of the DOT such as Staycations without age restrictions shall remain to be allowed at such capacities, protocols and restrictions as may be imposed by the DOT.
- (h) Interzonal travel shall be allowed subject to restrictions of the local government unit of destination. Point-to-Point travel to areas under General Community Quarantine and Modified General Community Quarantine shall be allowed without age restrictions subject to an RTPCR test-before-travel requirement for those below eighteen years old (18) and above sixty-five (65), and other protocols and restrictions as may be imposed by the DOT and the Local Government Unit of destination.
- (i) Religious gatherings shall be allowed up to ten percent (10%) of the venue capacity. Provided that, there is no objection from the local government unit where the religious gathering may take place. Provided, further, that the LGU may increase the allowable venue capacity up to thirty percent (30%). The religious denominations should strictly observe their submitted protocols and the minimum public health standards.

Gatherings for necrological services, wakes, inurnment, funerals for those who died of causes other than COVID-19 shall be allowed, provided that the same shall be limited to immediate family members, upon satisfactory proof of their relationship with the deceased and with full compliance with the prescribed minimum public health standards for the duration of the activity.

- (j) Other provisions of the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines, as amended, not affected by the foregoing shall continue to be in effect including those on interzonal travel into and out of the aforementioned areas and the operation of public transportation. The use of active transportation.

**SECTION 3. Movement of Fully Vaccinated Senior Citizens.** Paragraph C of IATF Resolution No. 120 s 2021, is hereby adopted;

*“C. The movement of fully vaccinated senior citizens in areas under General Community Quarantine and Modified General Community Quarantine shall be allowed, subject to the presentation of a duly issued COVID-19 vaccination card. Provided that no interzonal travel shall be allowed other than point-to-point travel under IATF Resolution No. 118-A s. 2021. Provided further, that strict observance of minimum public health standards shall continue.”*

**SECTION 4. Penalties.** Barangays and all establishments located in the Municipality should ensure strict enforcement of safety protocols to prevent the spread of Covid-19. All existing applicable laws and ordinances shall be pursued against those who fail to follow the provision of this Executive Order.

**SECTION 5. Dissemination.** All Punong Barangays are directed to disseminate this Order to everyone with their respective territorial jurisdiction. The Municipality of Los Baños, Public Information Office, will likewise post media information platforms for widest dissemination.

**SECTION 6. Repealing Clause.** All other issuances, order, memorandum which are inconsistent herewith are hereby amended or repealed accordingly;

**SECTION 7. Separability Clause.** If, for any reason, any part of provision of this order be declared invalid, any part or provision not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect;

**SECTION 8. Effectivity.** This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until lifted or amended by another order or superseded by law or ordinance.
