**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 090**

**CREATION OF THE ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE FOR THE PHILIPPINE  
NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) COMMUNITY MOBILIZATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 states “Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants”;

**WHEREAS**, CALABARZON Police Regional Office (PRO) Memorandum Circular No. 2017-02 dated July 3, 2017 provides for the Community Mobilization Project (CMP) defining the strategic concepts, providing guidelines and procedures to implement the PRO CALABARZON Crime Prevention Program in partnership with the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and other concerned agencies;

**WHEREAS**, the CMP is a part of the Local Anti-Criminality Action Plan (LACAP) including the creation of an Assessment Committee. This project aims to establish a strong and sustainable community defense system and the maintenance of peace and order in a locality which is a shared responsibility between people and the police;

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to create the Assessment Committee to empower and mobilize the community through active participation by allowing citizens to share in the decision making and responsibilities with the police and the government;

**WHEREAS**, the involvement of both public and private sectors can have a better impact when coordinated and integrated;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTONIO L. KALAW**, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Los Baños, Province of Laguna, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby create the Assessment Committee for the PNP CMP.

**SECTION 1. Composition.** The Assessment Committee for the CMP shall be composed of the following:

**SECTION 2. Duties and Functions.** The Assessment Committee shall perform the following:

1. Supervise, monitor, and ensure the implementation of the program in connection with the requirements of the DILG.
2. Coordinate the program with other concerns for its success and effectiveness.
3. Participate and cooperate in the implementation of the program by reinforcing Barangays
4. Detect possible crimes and report pertinent information for crime solution and crime prevention.
5. Promote public safety measure by cooperating with concerned agencies/offices.
6. Prepare budget requirements for the programs and other activities.
7. Perform such tasks that may be requested.

**SECTION 3. Meeting.** The Assessment Committee shall meet at least once every month or as may be necessary to assess the implementation of the program whether it has positive effects to the overall peace and order situation in the municipality.

**SECTION 4. Effectivity.** This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until lifted or amended by another order or superseded by law or ordinance.
