WHEREAS, Republic Act. No. 10121 known as the “The Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010” was approved and signed in law in 2010 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) issued by the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council thereafter;

WHEREAS, Section 11 of the Act and Rule 5 of its IRR stated that the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) shall approved, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plans, regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;

WHEREAS, the MDRRMC further agreed to include these projects in the Annual Investment Program CY 2022 of the Municipality of Los Baños;

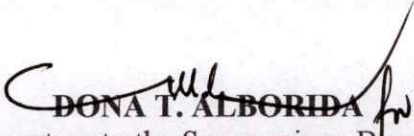
