ORDINANCE NO. 2023-2372

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE ENTIRE STRETCH OF LUNA STREET AND VILLEGAS STREET IN BARANGAY BAYBAYIN, J.P. RIZAL STREET IN BARANGAY TIMUGAN AND LOPEZ AVENUE IN BARANGAY BATONG MALAKE, LOS BAÑOS, LAGUNA FOR THE CONDUCT OF EVENTS IN CELEBRATION OF THE 22ND BAÑAMOS FESTIVAL IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE 408TH FOUNDATION ANNIVERSARY OF LOS BAÑOS.

WHEREAS, Section 21 of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides the manner of closure and opening of roads:

“Section 21. Closure and Opening of Roads –

(a) A local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park or square falling within its jurisdiction...

x x x

(c) Any national or local road, alley, park, or square may be temporarily closed during an actual emergency, or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs or an undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications, and waterworks projects, the duration which shall be specified by the local chief executive concerned in a written order... ”

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Los Baños will celebrate the 22nd Bañamos Festival from September 17 to 24, 2023 in conjunction with its 408th Founding Anniversary;

WHEREAS, several activities and/or festivities will be conducted during the 22nd Bañamos Festival such as, but not limited to Thanksgiving Mass, Carnival Fair, Bañamos Kick Off (Shower Parade), Palarong Bañamos, Kakaibangka, Bailamos, Zumbaños, LB Awards (Iconic Businesses, Top Ten Taxpayer, Search for Outstanding Citizen), Barangay Night, Cultural Show, LBirit Star Search, Bañamos Aquagames, Mister and Miss Bagong Los Baños, Color Run, Civic Parade, Hot Air Balloon Fiesta plus Market Bazaar, Bayle sa Kalye, Padyak LB, Grand Revelry “Colors of Bañamos”, among others;

WHEREAS, all activities and/or festivities to be conducted during the 22nd Bañamos Festival are hereby approved and authorized;

WHEREAS, in his letter dated August 25, 2023, the Honorable Mayor Anthony F. Genuino urgently requested the august body for the passage/enactment of appropriate legislative measure for the temporary closure of a portion of Luna Street in Barangay Baybayin, J.P. Rizal Street in Barangay Timugan and Lopez Avenue in Barangay Batong Malake, Los Baños, Laguna for the conduct of some events in celebration of the 22nd Bañamos Festival in conjunction with its 408th Foundation Anniversary;

WHEREAS, in order to ensure the successful staging of some of the events, the temporary closure of a portion of Luna Street in Barangay Baybayin, J.P. Rizal Street in Barangay Timugan and Lopez Avenue in Barangay Batong Malake, Los Baños, Laguna is required;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Mike Dexter A. Concio, duly seconded by Councilor Marlo PJ A. Alipon and concurred by all Councilors present;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LOS BAÑOS, LAGUNA, in session assembled, **THAT**:

SECTION 1. TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE FOLLOWING ROADS. A portion of Luna Street in Barangay Baybayin, Rizal Street in Barangay Timugan and Lopez Avenue in Barangay Batong Malake, Los Baños, Laguna is hereby temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic during the events, dates and times herein below respectfully provided, to wit:

A. Luna Street, Barangay Baybayin, Los Baños, Laguna

D. Villegas Street, Barangay Baybayin, Los Baños, Laguna

SECTION 2. ALTERNATE ROUTE.

All motorists are directed to utilize alternate routes indicated herein during the temporary closure of the specified roads:

- In the closure of Luna Street in Barangay Baybayin, all motorists may utilize J.P. Rizal Street, Lopez Street, L. Jaena Street, and Villegas Street;
- In the closure of J.P. Rizal Street in Barangay Timugan, all motorists may utilize Villegas Street, M. Aquino Street, Revilla Street. L Jaena Street and J. Luna Street;
- In the closure of Lopez Avenue, all motorists may utilize the Jamboree Road, UPLB and Maahas Road.
- In the closure of Villegas Street in Barangay Baybayin, all motorists may utilize the National Highway.

SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISION. The Office of the Municipal Mayor through the Municipal Engineering Office and the Los Baños Traffic Management Office (LBTMO) shall provide the necessary mechanisms in the proper implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. INFORMATION DISSEMINATION. The Municipal Public Information Office (PIO) shall conduct appropriate information campaign to ensure that the public is made aware of the provisions of this Ordinance.

The public shall also be informed that during the temporary road closure, essential personnel and emergency cases as such are excluded in the implementation of this ordinance.

All persons affected are hereby advised to plan ahead their trips and/or use the available alternate routes, or amend their schedules as may be deemed appropriate.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts not consistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the court, or suspended or revoked by competent authorities, other parts or the provisions thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be full force and effect.


SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take force and effect upon approval.
